This product supports the following standards:

1. **Students read many different types of print and nonprint texts for a variety of purposes.** *Emotions* includes 22 photographs for students to interpret, describe, and discuss.
2. **Students use a variety of strategies to build meaning while reading.** The images and activities in this set help build background knowledge about emotions that assists students in understanding what they read.
3. **Students communicate in spoken, written, and visual form, for a variety of purposes and a variety of audiences.** Since these cards are designed as conversation starters, they support verbal communication skills.
4. **Students whose first language is not English use their first language to learn English and to understand content in all curriculum areas.** This product is ideal for use with English language learners as the images can be used to build vocabulary related to emotions both in their first language and in English. In addition, all picture descriptions and activity instructions are available in both English and Spanish.
5. **Students become participating members of a variety of literacy communities.** Because the activities in this set focus on group discussions about the photographs, they are a very effective way to help build a classroom literacy community.
6. **Students use spoken, written, and visual language for their own purposes, such as to learn, for enjoyment, or to share information.** This set helps teach students emotions-related vocabulary they can use to express their own feelings.
