Students whose first language is not English use their first language to learn English and to understand content in all curriculum areas.** The images in this set can be used with students of various language backgrounds to introduce manners, and the captions and activity directions are available in both English and Spanish to support English language learners.
- 5. Students become participating members of a variety of literacy communities.** Because the activities in this set focus on group discussions about the photographs, they are a very effective way to help build a classroom literacy community.
